CLARENCE FIRE DISTRICT NO. 1

FIRE APPARATUS USE OUTSIDE THE FIRE DISTRICT

I. <u>SCOPE</u>:

This policy applies when Fire District vehicles leave the Fire District for non-emergency use.

II. OBJECTIVE:

The objective of this policy is to set up a standard operating procedure for the use of fire vehicles outside the Fire District.

III. **GUIDELINES**:

In an effort to eliminate confusion about our fire vehicles leaving the Fire District, the following guidelines are hereby established:

- A. The Chief shall request approval of the Board of Fire Commissioners at a District meeting.
- B. Recognizing that occasionally situations arise that do not allow for approval at a meeting, two or more Commissioners may grant approval. This approval shall be reported by the Chief at the next District meeting.
- C. Authority to grant the use of fire apparatus outside the Fire District rests solely with the Board of Fire Commissioners.

This policy is adopted March 12, 2012 and supersedes the previous reversion of this policy adopted May 9, 2005.
