CLARENCE FIRE DISTRICT NO. 1

EMERGENCY VEHICLE SPEED POLICY

I. <u>SCOPE</u>:

This policy applies to all members of the Clarence Fire District No. 1 who drive emergency vehicles owned and operated by Clarence Fire District No. 1.

II. OBJECTIVE:

The primary objective of this policy is to set forth official instructions, rules and regulations when an individual fire person operates any emergency vehicle.

III. <u>DISTRICT GUIDELINES</u>:

The following guidelines are hereby established.

- A. When approaching a red light, a stop sign or a railroad crossing, all emergency vehicles will come to a complete stop. The intersection must be controlled and deemed safe before proceeding.
- B. The maximum speed is:
 - 1. Ambulance 55 MPH
 - 2. All other vehicles posted speed limit
- C. When traffic conditions require emergency vehicles to travel in an oncoming lane, the maximum speed shall be 20 MPH.
- D. It shall be the responsibility of the Clarence Fire District No. 1 Chief, or his official designee, to instruct and/or promulgate this policy to all members who drive Clarence Fire District emergency vehicles.
- **IV.** This policy does not supersede New York State Department of Transportation Laws and all vehicle and traffic laws shall be obeyed.
- **V.** There are no exceptions to the above-stated guidelines.
- **VI.** This policy may be amended at any time.

This policy is adopted February 11, 2013 and supersedes the previous versions of this policy adopted June 8, 2003.
